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98 POINTS	2022 Seascape Vineyard Sonoma Coast CHARDONNAY	The 2022 Seascape Vineyard Chardonnay needs a fair bit of swirling to unlock notes of lemon tart, guava, and key lime pie leading to hints of brine, fresh ginger, and yuzu zest. The medium to full-bodied palate is electric, featuring intense citrus and mineral layers with a silky texture, finishing with epic length. This should age amazingly! Seascape Vineyard is located on a 1,000-foot-high panoramic ridgetop west of the town of Occidental, overlooking Bodega Bay and the Pacific Ocean. It was planted to the Spring Mountain Chardonnay clonal selection in the mid-1980s.
97 POINTS	2022 Jennifer's Russian River Valley CHARDONNAY	The 2022 Jennifer's Chardonnay pops from the glass with vibrant notes of fresh pineapple, honeydew melon, and lemongrass with suggestions of wet pebbles and fresh ginger plus a waft of lime blossom. The medium to full-bodied palate delivers amazing tension, with super-intense tropical and citrus fruit flavors, finishing long and zesty. Jennifer's Chardonnay is sourced from a dramatic, steep-sloped vineyard in the windy and very cool Sebastopol Hills neighborhood of the Russian River Valley AVA. The block was planted to Old Wente selection Chardonnay in 2005.
97 POINTS	Warrior Princess Block Zena Crown Vineyard, OR CHARDONNAY	The 2022 Warrior Princess Chardonnay jumps from the glass with notes of juicy pears and honeydew melon giving way to an evocative undercurrent of struck flint, grapefruit oil, and allspice. The medium to full-bodied palate delivers jaw-dropping tension juxtaposed with a creamy texture, finishing with an impressively persistent and refreshing steeliness. This is gorgeous! It is sourced from a block within the Zena Crown vineyard in the Eola-Amity Hills, planted to Dijon clone 95.
96 POINTS	2022 Far Coast Vineyard Sonoma Coast CHARDONNAY	The 2022 Far Coast Vineyard Chardonnay rockets out with vibrant notes of green mango, guava, and fresh pineapple opening out to hints of crushed rocks, sea spray, and baking bread. The medium to full-bodied palate is wonderfully elegant and soft-spoken, with seamless freshness leading to a long and savory finish. The estate Far Coast Vineyard is from blocks located on a mountain ridge north of Fort Ross on the Sonoma Coast, planted to Clone 15, Dijon 95, and Entav 809 at an elevation of 700 feet.
96 POINTS	2022 Fog Dance Vineyard Green Valley of the Russian River Valley CHARDONNAY	The 2022 Fog Dance Vineyard Chardonnay shoots from the glass with energetic notes of grapefruit oil and lemon curd leading to hints of lime cordial, jasmine tea, and white pepper. The medium to full-bodied palate delivers compelling tension with a chalky texture and loads of citrusy sparks on the long finish. Fog Dance Vineyard is from blocks planted to Dijon 96 and ENTAV 809, located on a hillside in Green Valley south of the town of Forestville in an area noted for its nightly fog intrusion.
96 POINTS	2022 Four Hearts Vineyard Russian River Valley CHARDONNAY	The 2022 Four Hearts Vineyard Chardonnay erupts from the glass with flamboyant scents of apple pie, ginger cake, and spiced pears followed by nuances of chamomile, Marcona almonds, and clover honey. The medium to full-bodied palate reveals a satiny texture with just enough freshness and a long, mineral-laced finish. It is sourced mainly from the Laguna Ridge neighborhood of the Russian River Valley, from vineyards planted in late 1970s and early 1980s to Old Wente, Sees, and Rued selections.
96 POINTS	2022 DuPratt Vineyard Mendocino Ridge CHARDONNAY	The 2022 DuPratt Vineyard Chardonnay springs with vivacious notes of lime leaves, orange blossom, and Granny Smith apples followed by suggestions of fresh grapefruit and yuzu zest. The medium-bodied palate is tightly knit and lively, with energetic citrus layers and a zesty finish. The DuPratt Vineyard, planted in the early 1980s, is nestled among coastal redwoods at 1,500 feet, in the Mendocino Ridges AVA.
95 POINTS	2022 Sevens Bench Vineyard Los Carneros CHARDONNAY	The 2022 Sevens Bench Vineyard Chardonnay sashays out with gregarious notes of apple butter, ripe peaches, and pear tart followed by nuances of lemon drops and honeysuckle with a touch of lime blossom. The medium to full-bodied palate has a crisp backbone and decadently oily texture with a long chalky finish. Sevens Bench Vineyard is sourced from blocks planted on eroded and rocky Haire Clay Loam soils in Carneros. The wine is a blend of UCD 27, Batto, Calera, and Long selections.





2022 The 2022 Stone Cote Vineyard Chardonnay prances out of the glass with showy notes of STONE CÔTE VINEYARD honey-drizzled peaches, ripe apricots, and honeycomb with wafts of candied ginger and wet SONOMA COAST pebbles. The medium to full-bodied palate is packed with orchard fruit flavors supported by a **CHARDONNAY** refreshing line and silky texture, finishing on a chalky note. Stone Cote is sourced from a block within the Durell vineyard planted to Upper Barn selection and UCD 4. The site is an uplifted river bed. The 2022 Three Jacks Vineyard Chardonnay bursts from the glass with bold notes of apple 2022 sauce, poached pears, and nutmeg followed by hints of ginger snaps and honeycomb. The THREE JACKS VINEYARD medium to full-bodied palate is so creamy and spicy, with well-knit freshness and a long and Green Valley of the gingery finish. Three Jacks Vineyard Chardonnay is sourced from a small vineyard in the heart Russian River Valley **CHARDONNAY** of the Green Valley in the Russian River Valley AVA. It was planted in 1995 to four clonal selections: Old Wente, Rued, Dijon 95, and Clone 15. The 2022 Chardonnay comes bounding out of the glass with eager-to-please notes of juicy ripe 2022 Russian River Valley pears, yellow apples, and powdered ginger with touches of acacia honey and lightly buttered **CHARDONNAY** toast. The medium-bodied palate has lovely harmony, with a satiny texture and a spicy kick to the finish. The Russian River Valley Chardonnay is a barrel selection from all of Hartford Court's Estate Designated Vineyard properties and select growers from all RRV neighborhoods: Middle Reach, Green Valley, Laguna Ridge, Santa Rosa Plain, and Sebastopol Hills. The 2022 Jurassic Vineyard Old Vine Chenin Blanc slowly emerges from the glass with notes 2022 of Golden Delicious apples, fresh pears, and wet slate plus touches of beeswax and coriander Jurassic Vineyard seed. The dry, medium-bodied palate delivers a satiny texture and racy acidity, finishing with a Santa Ynez Valley lemony lift. The Jurassic Vineyard, planted in 1982, is situated at an elevation of 1,000 feet. The CHENIN BLANC name pays tribute to the fossil-rich soils that force the vines to look deep for nutrients and water.

2022 Arrendell Vineyard Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR The 2022 Fog Dance Vineyard Pinot Noir is medium ruby-purple in color. Notes of black raspberries, blood orange, and redcurrant jelly pop from the glass, giving way to nuances of graphite, underbrush, and garrigue. The medium to full-bodied palate is tightly wound and intense, with fantastic tension and super fine-grained tannins, finishing long and savory. Fog Dance Vineyard is from a block located on a hillside in Green Valley south of the town of Forestville in an area noted for its nightly fog intrusion.

The 2022 Velvet Sisters Pinot Noir is medium ruby-purple in color. Wow! The nose is pure violets and rose oil, leading to a core of wild blueberries, Morello cherries, and crushed rocks with a touch of wild thyme. The full-bodied palate has a laser-fine, crisp backbone with grainy tannins and intense black and blue fruit layers, finishing on a lingering chalky note. It is sourced from a block within an estate vineyard located at the northern end of Anderson Valley, planted to Dijon clones 115, 667, 777, and Pommard.

Medium ruby-purple in color, the 2022 Arrendell Vineyard Pinot Noir slowly reveals notes of black cherries, fresh raspberries, and redcurrant leading to suggestions of bay leaves, mossy tree bark, and lavender. The medium to full-bodied palate is plush and refreshing, with loads of savory sparks and a long lifted finish. Arrendell is a vineyard planted in 1975 to the heritage Martini clone. The vineyard, one of the coldest in the Russian River Valley, struggles to ripen less than one ton per acre of Pinot by Halloween most years.





95 POINTS	2022 Far Coast Vineyard Sonoma Coast PINOT NOIR	Medium ruby-purple in color, the 2022 Far Coast Vineyard Pinot Noir shimmies out of the glass with energetic scents of Bing cherries, fresh strawberries, and mulberries followed by hints of roses, forest floor, and blood orange. The medium to full-bodied palate is very tightly wound, with impressive tension and a very long minerally finish. It is sourced from a block located on a mountain ridge north of Fort Ross on the Sonoma Coast. The well-drained soils at an elevation of 800-1000 feet produce wines with a great sense of focus and minerality.
95 POINTS	2022 Hailey's Block Green Valley of the Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	Medium ruby-purple in color, the 2022 Hailey's Block Pinot Noir opens with evocative notes of wild thyme, dried lavender, damp soil, and moss leading to a core of redcurrants, orange peel, and black pepper. The medium to full-bodied palate has firm, fine-grained tannins and a racy backbone providing a firm structure for the bright, muscular fruit, finishing long and tangy. From a very cool spot in Green Valley, Hailey's Block lies within the Arrendell Vineyard and is named after Don and Jennifer Hartford's daughter.
95 POINTS	2022 MacLean's Block Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	The 2022 Maclean's Block Pinot Noir is medium ruby-purple in color. Scents of ripe blackberries, mulberries, and boysenberries leap from the glass, followed by nuances of licorice, tar, and underbrush. The medium to full-bodied palate is bursting with blackberry and savory layers, supported by fine-grained tannins and a lively line, finishing earthy. It is named after Don & Jennifer Hartford's son MacLean. MacLean's Block is on a vineyard located on a gentle east-facing slope, east of the town of Occidental.
95 POINTS	2022 Muldune Trail Anderson Valley PINOT NOIR	The 2022 Muldune Trail Pinot Noir is medium ruby-purple in color. Wonderfully fragrant notes of red roses and cinnamon toast give way to a core of kirsch, raspberry pie, and allspice with a hint of forest floor. The medium to full-bodied palate is soft and juicy with a racy line to support, finishing long and spicy. It is sourced from an estate vineyard at the southern end of the Anderson Valley, located atop a 1,600-foot ridge.
95 POINTS	2022 Seascape Vineyard Sonoma Coast PINOT NOIR	Medium ruby-purple in color, the 2022 Seascape Vineyard Pinot Noir struts from the glass with forthright notes of black cherries, black raspberries, and orange peel followed by hints of black pepper, juniper, and lavender. The medium to full-bodied palate is plush and vibrant, with perfumed black and red berry layers, finishing long and fragrant. Seascape Vineyard is located on a panoramic ridgetop west of the town of Occidental, facing Bodega Bay and the Pacific Ocean.
94 POINTS	2022 Jennifer's Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	Medium ruby-purple in color, the 2022 Jennifer's Pinot Noir jumps from the glass with scents of redcurrants, Bing cherries, and raspberry leaves followed by wafts of wood smoke, dried herbs, and dusty soil. The medium to full-bodied palate delivers smoky red berry flavors with a light chewiness to the texture and a refreshing herbal lift on the finish. Jennifer's is sourced from a vineyard south of Sebastopol influenced by the cold maritime air feeding the Petaluma Wind Gap. This very cool site ripens late in the season and produces distinct wines with great aging potential.
94 POINTS	2022 Truly Rita Sta. Rita Hills PINOT NOIR	Medium ruby-purple in color, the 2022 Truly Rita Pinot Noir bursts with vivacious notes of Morello cherries, pomegranate, and fresh mulberries leading to suggestions of garrigue, crushed rocks, and wild sage. The medium to full-bodied palate is tightly wound with fine-grained tannins and compelling tension, finishing on an evocative minerally note. It is sourced from the Dierberg-Drum Canyon Vineyard in the Sta. Rita Hills AVA, on blocks planted to two field selections: Calera and Swan along with Dijon clone 115.
94 POINTS	2022 Warrior Princess Block Zena Crown Vineyard, OR PINOT NOIR	The 2022 Warrior Princess Pinot Noir is medium ruby-purple in color. Wow! It sashays out with showy notes of kirsch, raspberry coulis, and rose oil giving way to hints of cinnamon stick and dried Provence herbs. The medium to full-bodied palate is so smooth and satiny, with just enough freshness and finishing with a spicy lift. It is sourced from several blocks within the Zena Crown vineyard in the Eola-Amity Hills, on blocks planted to Dijon clones 667, 777,

and Pommard.





93 POINTS	2022 Land's Edge Vineyard Sonoma Coast PINOT NOIR	Medium ruby-purple in color, the 2022 Land's Edge Vineyard Pinot Noir scoots out of the glass with ready-to-go scents of wild strawberries, kirsch, and redcurrant jelly plus wafts of dried herbs, damp soil, and wet slate. The medium to full-bodied palate is refreshing and crunchy, with energetic red berry flavors and fine-grained tannins, finishing with a mineral lift. Land's Edge Vineyard is sourced from Hartford Court's two Sonoma Coast vineyards, Far Coast and Seascape, both within 4 miles of the Pacific Ocean.
92 POINTS	2022 Russian River Valley PINOT NOIR	Medium ruby-purple in color, the 2022 Pinot Noir gives up eager-to-please scents of juicy strawberries and ripe raspberries followed by hints of violets, dark chocolate, and menthol. The medium to full-bodied palate is velvety and refreshing, with bags of red and black berry flavors, finishing with a minty lift. The Russian River Valley Pinot Noir is a barrel selection from all of Hartford Court's Estate and Designated Vineyard properties across the Green Valley, Laguna Ridge, Santa Rosa Plain, and Sebastopol Hills neighborhoods.
92 POINTS	2022 Sevens Bench Vineyard Los Carneros PINOT NOIR	The 2022 Sevens Bench Vineyard Pinot Noir is medium ruby-purple in color. Herbal notes of dried sage and bay leaves open out to a core of cranberries and strawberries with a hint of mossy tree bark. The medium to full-bodied palate is chock full of herbal and peppery flavors with a lightly chewy texture and refreshing line, finishing with an herbal lift. This Carneros vineyard is on a ridge at an elevation of 200 feet, part of an uplifted riverbed which allows good drainage in the traditional clay-based soils of the region. The name Sevens Bench is derived from the two clones planted on the block: Clone 37 (Mount Eden) and Dijon 777.
97 POINTS	2022 Dina's Vineyard Russian River Valley OLD VINE ZINFANDEL	Medium to deep garnet-purple in color, the 2022 Dina's Old Vine Zinfandel flies from the glass with notes of charcoal, wet rocks, and black truffle leading to a core of baked blueberries and stewed plums plus wafts of sandalwood and tree bark. The full-bodied palate has a seriously racy backbone of acidity and velvety tannins supporting the generous earth-laced blue fruit layers, finishing with epic length. This comes mostly from head-trained vines planted over 100 years ago.
97 POINTS	2022 Highwire Vineyard Russian River Valley OLD VINE ZINFANDEL	The 2022 Highwire Zinfandel Old Vines is medium to deep garnet-purple in color. It comes barreling out of the glass with notes of baked cherries, black truffle, juicy blueberries, and spice cake with hints of oolong tea and mossy tree bark. The full-bodied palate is lively and fine-grained, with earth-laced black and red berry layers, finishing long and earthy. The vines are more than 100 years old, with half of the plot head-trained and half trained on a high wire.
96 POINTS	2022 Fanucchi-Wood Road Vineyard Russian River Valley OLD VINE ZINFANDEL	The 2022 Fanucchi Wood Road Zinfandel Old Vine is medium to deep garnet-purple in color. Notes of juicy blackberries and baked plums on the nose open out to suggestions of unsmoked cigars, dried rose, tilled soil, and wild fungi. The full-bodied palate is dense and muscular, with a rock solid structure of grainy tannins and plenty of freshness, finishing long and earthy. The vines were planted over 100 years ago and have been trained up to chest level to increase air circulation and sun exposure for the berries.
95 POINTS	2022 Hartford Vineyard Russian River Valley OLD VINE ZINFANDEL	Medium to deep garnet-purple in color, the 2022 Hartford Zinfandel soars with notes of rose oil, star anise, kirsch, and raspberry pie leading to a core of stewed red plums and incense. The medium to full-bodied palate has a refreshing backbone and lightly chewy texture, finishing with lovely purity and a red berry lift. Don and Jennifer Hartford tend this head-trained vineyard in the backyard of their home. Planted over 100 years ago, the Hartford Vineyard's vines are the lowest yielding of all of their Old Vine Zinfandel vineyards.
95	2022	Medium to deep garnet-purple in color, the 2022 Jolene's Vineyard Old Vine Zinfandel bursts

with bold notes of Morello cherries, rosebud tea, hoisin, and unsmoked cigars giving way to hints of rose oil and sandalwood. The full-bodied palate has great tension and wonderfully

velvety tannins, with a compelling mintiness lifting the concentrated black fruits, finishing

long and spicy. It comes from head-trained vines planted over 100 years ago.

95 POINTS 2022 Winberrie Knolls Russian River Valley OLD VINE ZINFANDEL The 2022 Winberrie Knolls Old Vine Zinfandel is medium to deep garnet-purple in color. It bounds out of the glass with exuberant notes of juicy plums, boysenberry preserves, and fruitcake plus hints of Indian spices, dried mint, tobacco leaf, and potpourri. The full-bodied palate is jam packed with black fruits and exotic spices with a racy line and lightly chewy tannins, finishing very long and earthy. The vines are more than 100 years old.

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2022 Hartford Court Russian River Valley OLD VINE ZINFANDEL Medium to deep garnet-purple in color, the 2022 Old Vine Zinfandel flies out with profound scents of baked blackberries and plum preserves followed by hints of raspberry leaves, dried herbs, and cracked black pepper. The full-bodied palate is both refreshing and rich, with plush tannins and a long, earthy finish. This is a blend of six Designated Vineyard properties - old-vine, dry-farmed and low-yielding vineyards from the Russian River Valley AVA. The vines are more than 100 years old on average.

95 POINTS 2017 Outer Limits Sonoma Coast SYRAH Deep garnet-purple in color, the 2018 Outer Limits Vineyard Syrah prances out with pretty notes of crushed black cherries, fresh blackberries, and black raspberries leading to hints of cracked black pepper, tar, violets, and garrigue. The medium to full-bodied palate is beautifully fragrant, with a firm frame of rounded tannins and bags of freshness, finishing long and peppery. This is sourced from a south-west facing block located on a mountain ridge north of Fort Ross on the Sonoma Coast.
